Road Works Progressing in Fitzroy Crossing

Over 5kms of road works are progressing in Fitzroy Crossing with work underway on various sections of the Geikie Gorge Road including the intersection with Russ Road, Russ Road from Forrest Road over the Brooking Channel, the Sanford and Skuthorpe intersection realignment and Bell Road. The works are set to be completed by June 30 and total work cost is approximately 2 million (inc gst). The work is part of Council's current budget and Road Management Strategy 2020-25 Sealed Roads – April 2020.

The program takes place at the Youth Centre and Derby Recreation Centre. Youth are provided with dinner and can be dropped home by the Youth team after attending the program.


