CLARENDON STREET - REALISING THE VISION

The recent installation of the stylised pedestrian crossing gates marks that completion of this stage of the Clarendon Street Enhancement project is drawing nearer. The next tasks will primarily be focussed on the installation of the landscaping features as set out within the plan that was developed in conjunction with a community working group and then with further input from the broader community gathered at public information sessions and presentations.

One of the guiding objectives was to create a sense of place that recognised the rich history of the area and to create a place that is welcoming for residents and visitors. The stylised station gates installed at the three pedestrian crossings pay respect to the role Derby has had and continues to play in supporting the regions pastoral industry. The Kimberley Colour Stone boulders are iconic features of our region and the planting of additional trees and shrubs will help to contribute to the comfort and attractiveness of the area.

Future stages will focus on the opportunities to beautify the carpark area and also to identify opportunities to incorporate public art that can help celebrate and recognise the history and culture of our town.

We again give our thanks to our local business owners and the community for their ongoing support as works are undertaken.

OUTCOMES FROM ORDINARY COUNCIL MEETING HELD 27 OCTOBER 2016

1. **Awarding of Tender T06-2016** - Construction of the Youth Centre ablution block on Reserve 6929, Lot 500 Hardman Street, Derby has been awarded to H&M Tracey Pty Ltd.
2. **Additions to Mary Island Fishing Club** - Council has granted planning approval for works that include the placement of a second hand transportable amenities buildings, construction of new decking and shade areas, installation of playground and basketball court, installation of new perimeter fencing; and relocation of existing sea containers (storage) on the site subject to conditions.
