WEST KIMBERLEY PARKS TO REMAIN CLOSED UNTIL MID MAY

The Department of Parks and Wildlife wishes to advise that the parks in the West Kimberley remain closed due to the prolonged wet season and extensive damage to roads throughout the area.

Windjana Gorge and Tunnel Creek National parks and King Leopold Range Conservation Park (Bell Gorge, Lennard Gorge and Mt Hart) are currently closed.

WET SEASON ROAD CONDITIONS

We currently have many roads closed as a result of wet season rains. They are closed for your safety and to protect the surface of the road. The use of closed roads results in additional time and expense to repair, further prolonging the closure. Current road closures are available on our website.
