OCTOBER COUNCIL MEETING

Outcomes from the October Council meeting were as follows:

- Endorsed the Shire of Derby/West Kimberley Compliance Program;
- Approved the development application for the proposed extension to the existing Outbuilding at No. 31 (Lot 10) Knowsley Street West, Derby;
- Conveyed support for the Firefighting resources at Camballin; and
- Appointed WALGA as the CEO Recruitment Consultant. The current CEO's 5 year contract expires at the end of March 2019. Stephen Gash advised he was grateful for the opportunity and support of the community but would not be seeking a contract renewal, noting it would be exciting times for a new CEO to help the Council through the start of a new phase of growth.
