Be a vocal local and have your say in the upcoming local government elections

In-person voting is still available in Derby and Fitzroy Crossing for the Shire of Derby/West Kimberley (SDWK) local government elections, until polling day on Saturday 16 October 2021.

Ballots can be cast during business hours at the Derby Administration Centre and the Fitzroy Crossing Visitor Centre prior to polling day.

If you would like to vote on election day itself, please see below the details for the voting venues:

- **Derby** is the Chief Polling Place.

The SDWK Council Chambers (near the Derby Library), is at 68 Clarendon St. Polling booths are open from 8am - 6pm on election day.

Votes can also be cast in Fitzroy Crossing on election day, although please note the reduced hours:

- **Fitzroy Crossing Visitor Centre**

Flynn Drive, Fitzroy Crossing. Booths are open

from 8am - 2pm on election day.

We have five vacancies in the elections and you are welcome to come down on election night and watch the official count which will take place in the Council Chambers, Derby, from 6pm onwards.

We would also like to wish retiring Cr Chris Kloss all the best and thank him for his contribution as a councillor over a combined total of ten years. We also acknowledge the service of former councillor Steve Ross who resigned from this role after being elected in 2019 and serving two years on Council.

Rolling up for a dose of Derby Vaxathon


