Permit applies for the purposes issued and vehicles listed only

- This permit is valid on the day of issue. The permit holder shall monitor rainfall in the area of proposed travel. If rain is received in the 12 hours preceding the proposed travel, the permit is invalid. The permit may be revoked at any time subject to weather / road conditions.
- Travel shall be in daylight hours only.
- No responsibility will be accepted by the Shire for any personal injury, bogged, disabled or damaged vehicles or any other loss howsoever arising from use of the road whilst closed. Any bogged or disabled vehicle is not to be recovered until the condition of the road pavement enables recovery without damage to the road and or drainage system.
- The permit holder indemnifies the Shire against any claim for vehicle damage, or any other loss arising howsoever from use of the road when closed to public traffic.
- Damage caused to the roads if used during unsuitable conditions may be debited to the vehicle owner, depending upon the circumstances.
- Use of the road is to be kept to a minimum.
- Extreme caution is required when travelling on the road especially at creek crossings where dead slow is the recommended requirement and care must be taken due to scouring of the road.

It is a requirement that a copy of this consent be carried in the vehicles authorised to use it for the inspection on demand by the Shire, Main Roads or Police.
