ENTRY FORM

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

ENTRY FEES

1. An entry fee of \$25 (Adult) and \$16.50 (Youth-17yrs and under) applies. Each photograph may only be entered into one category. A limit of three entries applies per person. Entry fees are not refundable.

2. Cheques are to be made payable to Shire of Derby West Kimberley (SDWK). Credit, debit and cash payments can be made in person or over the phone at Shire Administration.

3. Photographers posting or freighting artwork should notify Shire Administration and make payment by telephone prior to their artwork arrival.

4. Entry forms may be hand delivered to Shire Administration, sent by post to Kimberley Photographic Award, SDWK, PO Box 94, Derby, Western Australia, 6728, or emailed to kpa@sdwk.wa.gov.au.

5. Payment, entry form and entry **must** be received no later than close of business (4pm) Wednesday 14 June 2017. Late entries will be automatically disqualified from judging but may be exhibited at the discretion of the curator.

ENTRY DELIVERY

1. Photographic works can be hand delivered to the Shire Administration, suitably packaged and clearly marked with artwork label provided.

2. **FREE transport and return of photographic works is available for fully paid entries lodged on or before Tuesday 6th June 2017. See Transport details appendage attached to this entry for terms and conditions of free transport.**

3. **After June 6 2017** freight, postage and all other charges relating to delivery and collection of photographs submitted are the sole responsibility of the photographer. Return instructions are to be pre-arranged and listed on the entry form.

ENTRY PICK UP

1. Unsold photos may be collected from Derby Civic Centre from 10.00am-4.00pm on Friday 30 June.

2. Sold photographs will be collected by the purchaser. The event organiser will contact the artist to advise of their artwork sale.

3. Return freight and postage must be pre-arranged and return instructions should be included with your entry form. Items transported under the "FREE" transport terms and conditions will be returned to designated collection site for collection by owner.

EXHIBITION & ENTRY CONDITIONS

1. Photographers can enter up to 3 works in any nominated category for which they are eligible. The non-entered Acquisitive Award (Overall Winner) can be awarded to any photographer who qualifies for that award from any category. Photographs must be Kimberley related or themed.

2. All categories except the Open Non-Kimberley category are open to all Kimberley residents (a Kimberley resident is defined as somebody who is currently living in the Kimberley and has resided in the region for a minimum term of 6 months) Photographs must be Kimberley related or themed.

3. Any Kimberley resident (as defined above) or visiting person to the Kimberley is eligible to enter the Smartphone 'Snap & Send' Award. Photographs must be Kimberley related or themed. Entry is free, photographers must send the image in a IMB minimum file and include name, address and contact number in the body of the email. Smartphone images will not be for sale and will feature in a montage. Inappropriate and unrelated Kimberley images will not be featured or judged. Snap & Send entries are NOT eligible in any other category.

4. Non-Kimberley residents may enter the Open Non-Kimberley category. The same general conditions apply in all other respects.

5. An electronic media copy of all digital photos must be provided with the image for the purposes of 'fair use.' The file should be at least 3MB size and on a labelled disc, flash drive or other suitable recording device or emailed direct to kpa@sdwk.wa.gov.au. A jpeg file format is preferred. Photos are required to be supplied free of water marks.

6. Photographers shall include an indication of whether the photograph has been digitally manipulated and the details of that manipulation.

7. Photo 'editing' generally consists of smaller changes that do not change the image in any fundamental way. This is acceptable for all the categories entered.

8. Creative / Altered Reality Prints are digital art images created or drastically altered in software such as Adobe Photoshop® or Microsoft Office. The digital techniques used to create the picture must be detailed in the description of your photo. Creative / Altered Reality Photographs can only be entered in the Creative / Altered Reality category.

9. It is the entrants responsibility to confirm that each person depicted in any entry has granted permission to be portrayed.

10. The Shire reserves the right of judges and curators to re-assign work to another category.

11. The maximum acceptable size of a photograph is 1.5m X 1.5m. Sizes exceeding this limit will be automatically disqualified from judging and may be exhibited at the discretion of the curator.

12. Each entry shall be the original work of the photographer and not copied in full or part from any production or published work or article. Previously entered works will not be accepted.

13. Photographs **must** be presentable for exhibiting; suitably framed or stretched on canvas (no frame required for canvas entries) and fitted with secure hanging wires or string using fixation points and latch systems. Insufficiently hung photos or photos entered with no hanging system will be automatically disqualified from judging but may be exhibited at the discretion of the curator. (see visual examples).

14. The SDWK and other sponsors reserve the right to purchase photographs prior to the official exhibition opening event on Saturday 24 June 2017.

15. All entries must be FOR SALE except those which are required to be returned for educational purposes. If you require your photographs to be marked NOT FOR SALE for educational purpose please tick the applicable box on your application form. There are no other exceptions.

16. Each photograph must have a label firmly attached to the back of their work.

17. A commission of 18% will be deducted from all sales revenue. The judges' decisions are final and cannot be contested. Council and curators reserve the right to withhold prizes in any section should the supporting information be found to be false. Council reserves the right of the Curator to select works to be exhibited or to choose not to exhibit works.

18. No responsibility will be accepted for loss or accidental damage of any photos submitted or entered. SDWK does not accept or insure against any liability for loss or damage of photographic work submitted or entered, before during or after the exhibition. Photographers submit entries at their own risk and insurance is the responsibility of the photographer.

19. All submitted photos are required to be available for exhibition for the duration of the competition.

20. In entering the competition the photographer grants permission to the SDWK and Principal Partner Christine Stokes, to use their photograph or any appropriate reproduction of the image for the purposes of private use, advertising and promotion of the Kimberley Photographic Award and/or the Kimberley during or after the exhibition.

21. The Overall Award is an acquisitive award. Should a winner carry a sale price in excess of the prize for that category the photographer agrees to accept the lesser amount.

22. Winners not present at the awards presentation evening will be contacted on Monday 26 June 2017.

23. Proceeds of sales and winnings will be processed by the end of **August 2017**. Payment of award and sales monies will be made by **Electronic Funds Transfer [EFT]** (cheque payment by request only). Please contact the Shire should you not have received funds by the 1st of September 2017.

24. All photos and categories are automatically entered in the People's Choice Award. Winner of the People's Choice Award will be contacted on Friday 30 June.

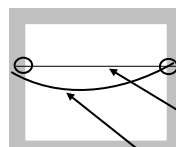

Examples of D-Latches which provide a secure and adjustable hanging system



Ensure hanging wire or frame is fixed 3/4 length of the frame for secure positioning



D-latches, firmly attached using screws

A good example of a hanging wire or string; tightly fixed across width of frame.

A bad example of a hanging wire or string; slack line means unstable hanging of artwork

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Photographers are required to include a written description or interpretation (of no more than 100 words) of their work that will enhance judges and viewers understanding of their work. Please be advised that descriptions more than 100 words will be reduced to fit the exhibition catalogue.

2. Please be reminded that photographs are to be strictly Kimberley themed or Kimberley related. While this term is very broad, it is expected an explanation will be given in the photo description.

3. Photographers or a representative are encouraged to attend the exhibition opening evening on Saturday 24 June to collect their award should they win as several photograph and media opportunities are available at the evening.

Categories

AQUISITIVE CATEGORY - OVERALL WINNER

This is not an entered category. The winner is judged from all categories and becomes property of the Shire of Derby/West Kimberley.

NON AQUISITIVE CATEGORIES

1. Kimberley Landscape

Outdoor beauty; including landscapes, outdoor scenes, skylscapes and seascapes to name a few. Note: if you enter a photo into this category, please include the place name or location in the title or description of your photo.

2. Character Portraits

Pictures of people from all walks of life in the Kimberley ie candid lifestyle shots or formal portrait of one or more people. Important: Ensure your portrait subject provides you with written permission for use of their image.

3. Creative / Altered Reality

Images created or drastically altered in software such as Adobe Photoshop® or Microsoft Office. Note: Please include the digital techniques and software used to manipulate your image in the description of your photo. Photos must be Kimberley related.

4. Black and White

This includes any photograph subject taken in a black and white format.

5. Flora

Entries can be taken on any Smartphone and emailed as an attachment (IMB minimum file size) to kpa@sdwk.wa.gov.au. This is an open category to both Kimberley residents and people living outside the region.

Entry is free however photos **must** be Kimberley related. Photographers should include photo title, description, their name, address and contact number in the body of the email when sending images. The Smartphone category may be entered up to three times. Smartphone images will be collated in a wall montage and are not eligible for any other category including acquisitive overall winner.
