INSTALLATION OF HERITAGE MARKERS UNDERWAY

The installation of markers on the heritage trail are due to be completed in early May.



There will be 30 panels in important historical locations along the route that includes Loch, Clarendon, Neville, Johnston and Elder Streets. Each panel includes historical information regarding the site and where possible photos of the original buildings.

The trail starts in front of the Derby Visitor Centre, with a trailhead

map and trail information. The Derby Heritage Trail is supported by brochures available at the Derby Visitors Centre from early May. This project has been made possible with funding from Lotterywest.
